A list of over 100 names with another 165 victims known but not yet identified which have already been put together by Mike McGrath, Trevor Mealham, Rob Green, Alun Richards and Francis.

If you believe you have been effected by any of the Lloyds Bank Bristol Recoveries/BSU's identified by Mike McGrath on page two, could you please forward your details to Mike: [mcgrath703@hotmail.com](mailto:mcgrath703@hotmail.com) who will then forward to the police to help with their investigations into this matter which is also being presented to Mr Kevin Hollinrake MP, co-chair of the All Party Political Group (APPG) for Banking who are looking into the actions of all the banks during the credit crunch.
